Instructions for abstracts
Abstract due date: April 30th 2009

The scientific committee will accept THREE (3) types of abstracts :

1) 10 minute ORAL presentation with 5 minutes for questions

This presentation is an ideal forum in which to present the results of research studies, or for the description of other projects or programs, whether of a clinical, health promotion, or wider focus. While the conference theme is global perspectives on adolescent sexual health, this is not the sole focus of the conference and abstracts are welcomed around a breadth of topics, including those that address clinical or community programs.

Accepted abstracts would then be clustered into sets of 3-4 related papers that would be presented within a single symposium session, facilitated by a professional who would provide an overview, facilitate discussion, and sum up the session.

Authors are encouraged to present abstracts that fit within the suggested topics for symposia.

Because of limited presenting times, those papers that are not accepted as an oral presentation may be invited to present the work as a poster. Please note that many program descriptions lend themselves better to a poster format.

2) POSTER presentation

These could be presentation of research or description of programs/projects

Please note that many program descriptions lend themselves better to a poster format rather than an oral presentation.

3) 60-90 minute WORKSHOP

Workshop topics related to the diversity of perspectives on adolescent sexual health are invited. These sessions are encouraged to be interactive and use multimedia, rather than didactic. Preference will be given to proposals that involve more than one country or perspective within the presentation.

General instructions for abstracts

Language for submission and presentation: English

Font: Times New Roman 12 font

1. Format for **ORAL or POSTER** presentation (must be less than one page, 12 font)

Title:

Full name, degrees, title, institution, address, telephone, FAX, and e-mail address of all authors

- Introduction/ Purpose
- Objectives
- Methods
- Results or description of program or project
- Discussion, conclusion

2. Format for **WORKSHOP** (must be less than two pages, 12 font)

Title:

Full name, degrees, title, institution, address, telephone, FAX, and e-mail address **FOR EACH** presenter

Learning Objectives (limit number to 1-4 learning objectives):

Brief description of the topic

Description of the content

Brief description of the format of the session (e.g., interactive, case presentations/discussions, didactic session, Q&A, video, etc.).
